

Big Sky Winter Adventure Itinerary

General Trip Summary

Day One:

9:00 am *Wake up to a fresh snowfall and glorious sunshine. A glorious breakfast buffet is available at Peaks Restaurant. From here you can step out to the terrace where our ski valets will hand over your skis. Just a few feet away, hop on the Ramcharger chairlift and head down into the Southern Comfort area to enjoy your warm up run on the sunny side of the mountain.*



Noon *Head to the Carabiner Lounge, in the Summit hotel, for lunch. Warm up with the Summit Game Chili made with antelope, bison & elk or the "Brick Oven" Pasta of the Day. Enjoy spectacular views of Lone Peak from the large glass windows and enjoy the Mountain View.*

1:00 pm *After lunch, warm up on Crazy Horse off the Swift Current before heading up to the bowl for a few runs. Then take the tram to the top where you will take in the ultimate 360-degree scenic view from 11,166 feet. From here, you can see two national parks, three states and the majestic Tetons. While you are taking in the breathtaking views, keep an eye out for Billie and Nanny Goats that call Lone Peak home.*



4:00 pm *Warm up with a hot drink and enjoy the live music at Montana Jack's before heading to the hot tub.*



6:00 pm *Relax in the newly renovated Solace Spa located in the Huntley Lodge. Treat yourself with the Gallatin River Hot Stone Massage where native stones are used in combination with 100% pure melted Shea Butter to deliver the ultimate sensory experience. Add personalized aromatherapy to enhance your relaxation. Afterwards, indulge in the High Altitude Hydrating Facial to nourish your skin with this intensely hydrating facial.*



8:00pm

Gather around a table at the Fondue Stube, inspired by traditional Swiss fondue and the original Big Sky Resort Fondue Stube that inhabited Chet's in the 1970s. You will be served cheese, broth/oil, and chocolate fondue in this intimate setting. The Fondue Stube is located in the Huntley Lodge within Big Sky Resort's Mountain Village Center. This is a true mountain experience.



Day Two:

8:00 am

Head to the Huntley Dining Room for breakfast, and enjoy a sumptuous made-to-order omelet off the breakfast buffet to start your day and keep you going all morning.

9:30am

Rent some snowshoes and enjoy a wonderful morning on a meandering peacefully through the Moose Tracks Gully.



Noon *Stop for a casual lunch at the Montana Smokehouse, a walk-up shack with picnic tables for outside eating. The Smokehouse serves burgers, chicken sandwiches, pulled pork, BBQ brisket, and kid-friendly foods. Let your nose lead the way to the aroma of smoked barbeque which abounds in the plaza.*

1:00 pm *Return to Basecamp to take in the Adventure Zipline. Ride up, then zip down on this tour which is designed for speed. Embark on the Explorer Double Chair, and take in expansive views of Lone Mountain and the Spanish Peaks of the Madison Range. Once you're at the top of the chair, let the zipping begin! Swoop your way down the mountain on four adrenaline pumping lines spanning up to 1,500 feet long and 150 feet above the forest floor, including a Twin Zipline where you can race your fellow adventure zippers.*



6:00 pm *It's time to really treat yourself to our elegant mid-mountain dining at Everett's 8800. Ride the chairlift up and take in the breath taking views as well as the finest cuisine offered in Big Sky. A five course American Alps Cuisine experience awaits you while you watch stunning mountain sunsets. At the end of the evening a safari truck will return you to the Summit Hotel.*

Day Three:

6:30am *Drop by the Hungry Moose Deli and grab a breakfast sandwich to go.*

6:45am *Catch the shuttle down to West Yellowstone for a day exploring the thermal features of our countries first national park. While Yellowstone's incredible natural features don't disappear in winter, they definitely change. Your guide will show you the magic of a misty geyser basin, where steam and plumes of water mix with freezing temperatures to cling to nearby objects, creating a mythical wonderland. 6:00pm *On your return, relax & revive in one of the many hot tubs/heated pool.*
