

BIG SKY Unemployment Rate Trend


Unemployment Rate: US, Montana, Gallatin County






Gallatin County Population Growth






Big Sky Peak Electrical Consumption

Daily Traffic Counts Meadow Village







Big Sky Real Estate Total \$ Volume


Total Real Estate Sold in Dollars




Number of enplanements





Monthly Enplanements: BZN








Resort Tax Collections by Month – Adjusted to exclude additional 1% implemented July 1, 2020*

Balance between Winter and Summer is staying consistent as the community grows.




Snowfall at BSR


<u>2022</u>

<u>2023</u>

- Traffic signal & pedestrian tunnel new MT64 & Little Coyote
- Roadway & intersection improvements at US 191 & Big Sky Resort
- Paved multi-use paths
