

LPP Sick Policy

Please review the rules set forth by Montana State's Public Health & Human Services Department and the Lone Peak Playhouse. Children exhibiting the following symptoms in the past 24 hours are prohibited from attending childcare services.

*Symptoms of a communicable disease, or being a carrier of such, as listed with Montana Health & Human Services, unless:

The child has been declared non-infectious by a licensed physician.

The child has been given approval by the state health department.

*Fever of 101 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, with no other symptoms present.

Please DO NOT use medications to reduce/mask fever before check in.

*Fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, with other symptoms present.

Please DO NOT use medications to reduce/mask fever before check in.

*Any Vomiting (including altitude sickness)

*Diarrhea, two or more episodes &/or stool cannot be contained by diaper

*Excessive & Abnormal (yellow/green) nasal discharge

*Any bacterial infections

Purulent Conjunctivitis/Pink Eye or excessive discharge from eyes

Strep Throat

Impetigo

Scarlet Fever

*Wheezing cough &/or Excessive coughing

*Any unexplained rashes or rashes covering large or multiple parts of the body

*Head Lice, until 48 hours after first treatment

*Scabies, until 48 hours after first treatment

Children needing antibiotics must be receiving their medication for at least 24 hours prior to attending childcare and be symptom free.

Parents &/or guardians please be ready to retrieve your children in a timely manner if any of the above symptoms become present during your child's stay at the Lone Peak Playhouse.
